Spiritually and one another. of the Spirit which is	3. <u>Body</u> : When the demonic forces of evil have influenced our minds and wills, we are moved into action to sin. The body suffers physically, spiritually, emotionally, and mentally (Psalm 32:1-4). The physical body may suffer from sexually transmitted diseases (STDs), & our sins sap us of all our energy. We suffer spiritually because we alienate ourselves from God & others. We suffer emotionally from anger & bitterness because that which we thought we were master over has now become our master.

and self-control (Galatians5:22-26). Mentally we experience peace, security, and contentment regardless of our situations or circumstances, because our strength is in Christ. Finally, when we practice the spiritual disciplines of confession & repentance on a daily basis, we are healed. Confession is most effective when we confess to both God & one another (Proverbs 3:1-8; 1 John 1:9; James 5:16).

4. <u>Conscience</u>: The conscience is a gift from God to tell the difference between right & wrong in accordance with God's laws. When our words, actions, deeds, and thoughts are in alignment with God's word and will, we have a clean conscience. Practicing the spiritual disciplines sharpens the godly conscience & keeps us free from falling victim to the deception of the demonic forces of evil, and guilt & shame (Romans 2:14-15; Acts 24:16). Furthermore, our conscience will also be clear from the accusations of the evil one who accuses us before God all day long (Revelation 12:10).

We suffer mentally from depression & anxiety because we have violated God's commands to be sexually pure.

4. <u>Conscience</u>: The conscience is a gift from God to tell the difference between right & wrong/truth & lie in accordance with God's laws. However, those who give into the false teachings of the demonic forces of evil will have their consciences seared, meaning they will no longer be able to tell the difference between the truth & a lie. That which was once right is wrong, and that which was once wrong is right and their conscience no longer bothers them, because it has become hardened & it is insensitive to its own feelings & the feelings of others. (Romans 1:18-32; 1 Timothy 4:1-3)
