

SEXUAL SIN & THE 10 COMMANDMENTS*

1st Commandment: “You shall have no other gods before Me.” Sexual lust is a god that we desire over God Himself.

5th Commandment: “Honor your father and your mother.” Sexual sin dishonors our parents through sexually transmitted diseases (STD’s); pregnancy outside of marriage, abortion, etc.
